

# BY-LAWS of THE WANDERERS CLUB

An association of members for sporting and recreation purposes

## 1. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- a. Persons entering the Club's property agree to abide by The Wanderers Club's Constitution, Rules and By-Laws which are available from the Club office and on the Club's website at [www.thewanderersclub.co.za](http://www.thewanderersclub.co.za).
- b. Persons entering agree to comply with any reasonable direction from management or any official connected with The Wanderers Club.
- c. Management has the right to request proof of membership and remove any person from the Club's premises if that person's behaviour is unacceptable.
- d. Persons under the influence of alcohol or any narcotic substance are prohibited from entering or remaining on the premises.
- e. No loud music which could cause a disturbance to other patrons may be played on the premises.
- f. No alcohol may be brought onto the premises by members or guests.
- g. Pets on foot or in a vehicle are not allowed.
- h. No roller skates, skateboards, or bicycles are allowed.
- i. The use of the sporting facilities is for members only. Visitors are allowed limited access if accompanied by a member or are participating in a tournament or league.
- j. Members are not permitted in any of the service, staff, or maintenance areas.
- k. The Club's telephone system is strictly for Club business only.
- l. The Covid-19 regulations and protocols must be always adhered to.

## 2. INDEMNITY

The Club accepts no liability for loss of personal property or personal injury.

### 5. DRESS CODE

- a. Smart-casual attire is required in all areas of the Clubhouse except when specified to the contrary for special functions.
- b. Regulation sporting attire is permitted in all areas of the Clubhouse including Chariots, Spinners and satellite bars.

### 6. MOTOR VEHICLES

- a. A speed of 15kph is in force within the Club precincts.
- b. Vehicles may only be parked in areas so demarcated. Any vehicle parked in a non-demarcated parking area will be clamped and the owner of such vehicle will be liable for an unclamping fee.
- c. Vehicles may not be left on the property overnight.
- d. Parking or driving on Club property is at own risk.

## **7. CHILDREN**

- a. Children between the ages of 2 and 17 years are permitted to dine in the Club in the company of an adult member.
- b. Children under the age of 10 must be always accompanied by an adult member.
- c. Children under 18 years of age are not allowed to sit at the bar counter or be served alcoholic beverages.
- d. Children are not allowed to use roller blades, skateboards, or bicycles anywhere on Club property.
- e. Children are not allowed on sporting facilities unless participating in supervised sport.

## **8. GUESTS/VISITORS**

- a. A member can bring a guest twice a month. Guests who use the facilities regularly will be required to become members.
- b. Members should accompany and are entirely responsible for their guest/s.
- c. Non-members cannot use the sporting facilities more than 3 times even if they are charged a visitor's fee. The sub-clubs are responsible to enlist regular visitors as members.
- d. Visiting teams and members of other clubs participating in leagues and competitions will be allowed entrance if their names are cleared by the relevant sub-club chairmen.

## **9. PETS**

Pets are not allowed (even if leashed or in vehicles) on Club property, with the exclusion of guide dogs.

## **10. MEMBERSHIP**

- a. Membership Cards (Smartcards) must be carried at all times and be presented upon request.
- b. Subscriptions must be paid by 31 May each year to avoid defaulting.
- c. Defaulters will be blocked and unable to use the Club facilities.
- d. Members may choose to pay their subscriptions by debit order which will attract a nominal admin fee. Members whose debit orders are returned unpaid will be defaulted.

## **11. SMARTCARDS AND DISCOUNTS**

- a. Members will receive a 10% discount on food and beverage transactions if they pay with their prefunded smartcard.
- b. Food and Beverage purchases may not be debited to members' accounts. Members may pay with cash, credit card or use their pre-funded smartcard. All transactions must be settled on the same day.
- c. Limited usage (Athletics, Karate) members will receive a 5% discount if paid with their prefunded smartcards once the Smartcard system is modified to cater for tiered discounts.
- d. Junior members (0-17 years old) can only prefund their smartcards up to a maximum of R200. A Junior membership Smartcard cannot be used to obtain discounts for other family members.
- e. Smartcards are not transferrable and may not be used by anyone else except the fully paid-up member.
- f. Each member may only have one smartcard at a time.
- g. Any abuse of Smartcard rules will result in the Smartcard being blocked.
- h. Smartcards can be prefunded online or at the Club's membership offices during normal office hours.
- i. Lost smartcards must be reported in order to be de-activated and replaced.
- j. Replacement smartcards may be purchased at a cost of R50.

## **12. FOOD, BEVERAGE & BANQUETING**

- a. Members or guests are not allowed to bring food or beverages onto the Club property.
- b. Members may have personal functions of up to a limited number of people in the Chariots function area and no venue hire will be charged. The 10% discount if paying by prefunded smartcard will apply.
- d. Members' personal functions of more than 100 people and all corporate functions will be catered by the banqueting service provider in the banqueting areas and discounts may be negotiated on an adhoc basis.
- e. Liquor may not be served to any member or guest under the age of 18 years.

## **13. SMOKING**

The lighting of pipes, cigars, cigarettes or e-cigarettes (vaping) is strictly prohibited anywhere inside the Club. Smoking can take place in outdoor areas but this is subject to change depending on smoking regulations.

## 14. SPORTING FACILITIES

- a. In certain sports (eg. Squash and Snooker) it is a requirement to pre-load the membership card to activate lighting. This can be done in the Membership office during normal office hours or online.
- b. A playing fee for guests for certain sports, (eg. Tennis and Basketball), must be paid at the Reception area of the main Clubhouse prior to commencement of play.
- c. Sport members may be requested to produce their membership card by a Club official.
- d. All children under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by an adult.
- e. Sports members are required to acquaint themselves with the rules and regulations pertaining to their particular sport and the Chairperson of each section can provide such information.
- f. Allocated practice/match times must be adhered to for specific sports. Should a match or practice time be out of scheduled time this must be approved by management in writing.
- g. Lockers are available to all players in the change rooms. Personal belongings may not be left overnight in the lockers.
